Great Hikes:

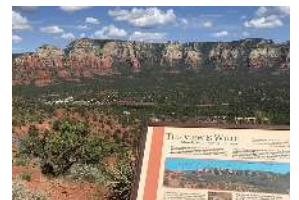
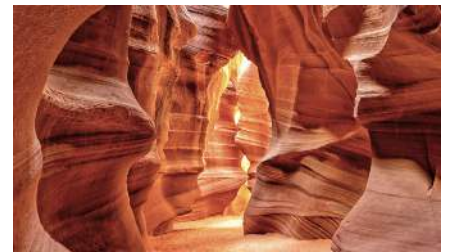
Challenging: Cathedral Rock Trail, Bell Rock Trail, Wilson Mountain Trail

Jeep Tour/ATV: The Jeep tours offering fun for kids, stunning views and are educational. We have personally enjoyed the Pink Jeep Tours but have heard great things about other companies. For those who want to drive it themselves, we recommend you rent an ATV.

Tlaquepaque: a charming and picturesque arts and crafts village, inspired by traditional Mexican plazas, offering a unique blend of galleries, shops, restaurants, and cultural events.

Day Trips: Sedona is conveniently located near a variety of special destinations such as the Grand Canyon, Flagstaff, Jerome, Antelope Canyon, among others.

Vortexes: Grand Chapel Estate is located in the Chapel of the Holy Cross Vortex, considered by many to be the “strongest” vortex. Each one has a unique energy, so enjoy exploring the 7 vortexes.

Chapel of the Holy Cross: a striking architectural marvel of a 90-foot cross seamlessly integrated into the red rock cliffs. It is well worth a visit to see its breathtaking views and serene spiritual ambiance.

Palatki Heritage Site: showcases ancient cliff dwellings and rock art of the Sinagua people, set amidst the stunning red rock landscape, revealing a rich tapestry of Native American history.
